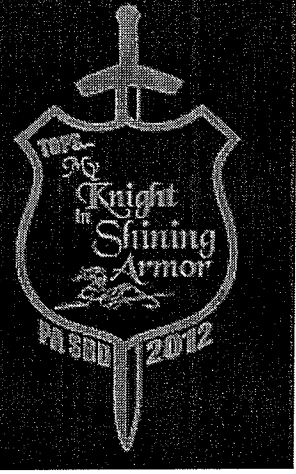


2012 PA State Recognition Days



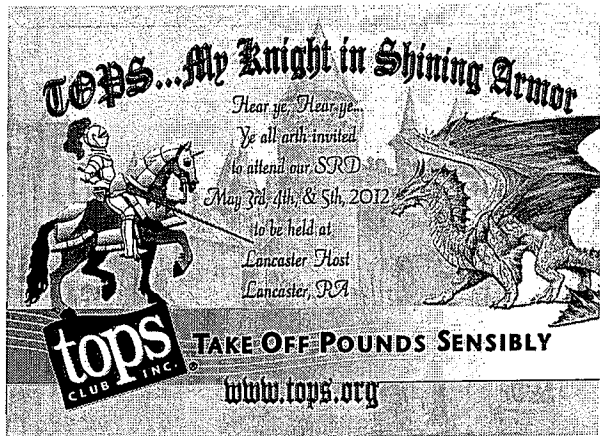

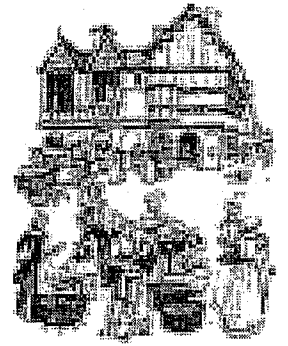
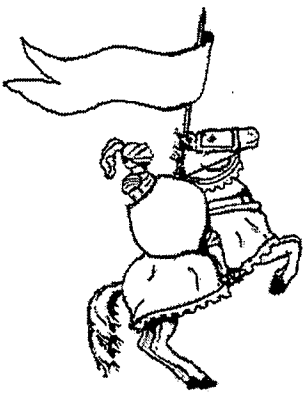

Friday Renaissance Faire

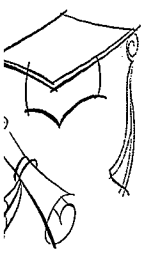
For our 1st General Session we are going to have a little fun. See below the following categories each chapter is able to participate in.
